
WELCOME to iSAT Study F2F Meeting II: Assembly and Infrastructure

NASA Langley Research Center October 2-4, 2018



Investigating the benefits of large telescope assembly in space, for the search for life in the Galaxy.

Background

Large-aperture telescopes benefit all astrophysics, as well as planetary and Earth science. They provide unprecedented spatial resolution, spectral resolution, and sensitivity to faint objects thus advancing all of these science areas. Envisioning the need for future large segmented telescopes to one day exceed the fairing size of existing or even planned launch vehicles, NASA will need to begin considering the in-space assembly (iSA) of these future assets.

In addition, robotically assembling space telescopes in space rather than deploying them from single launch vehicles offers the possibility of reduced cost and risk for even smaller telescopes. This possibility, however, has not been proven. Therefore, following discussions within NASA's Science Mission Directorate (SMD) and Astrophysics Division (APD), the SMD Chief Technologist and APD Division Director commissioned a study in the spring 2018 to assess the cost and risk benefits, if any, of the iSA of space telescopes. This study is called the in-Space Assembled Telescope or iSAT Study.

In particular, this study must answer the question: "When is it advantageous assembling space telescopes in space rather than building them on the Earth and deploying them autonomously from individual launch vehicles?" The goal for completion of the study is May 2019 culminating in a submitted whitepaper to the National Academies' 2020 Astronomy & Astrophysics Decadal Survey.

This is a key face-to-face meeting for Activity 1b of the NASA-chartered in-Space Assembled Telescope (iSAT) Study.

Activity 1b takes the modularized 20-meter space telescope developed in Activity 1a (reference telescope) and will examine concepts to assess:

- a) which robotics will assemble the telescope modules,
- b) which assembly platform will host the robotics,
- c) which orbit will the assembly platform travel in, and
- d) which launch vehicles will be required to transport the modules.

During this meeting we will:

- 1. advance and generate concepts to assemble the reference telescope and define its needed infrastructure,
- 2. advance the selection criteria in which we will prioritize these concepts.

Badge and Pass Information

Obtaining a Visitor Badge

If you are not a NASA employee, upon arrival at NASA LaRC you must stop at the Badge and Pass Office located at the main entrance to obtain a visitor badge. Once you receive your badge, you must have it displayed above the waist at all times while on Center and take out of the holder while going through the main gate.

Permanent or Temporary Employees

Permanent or temporary employees (working under contract) must be processed through "IdMAX".

Required Federal / State Government Issued Photo

All Visitors are required to present a Federal or State Government issued photo (e.g. Drivers license, state ID card, Government ID card.

The Badge and Pass Office will no longer accept state-issued driver's licenses or identity cards that fail to meet Department of Homeland Security (DHS) standards. Currently, those states/territories include Alaska, American Samoa, Arizona, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Montana, New York, Oklahoma, and Washington. Three of the above states (Minnesota, New York, and Washington) offer an Enhanced Driver's License (EDL), which will be acceptable. EDLs are identifiable by the American Flag on the face of the card. If you possess a license from one of the above listed states, please ensure you have an alternate form of identification with a photograph such as a passport, military ID, or federal employee badge.


Langley Research Center Map and Parking

Parking Options



Additional parking is located prior to building 2102. Take a right turn off of W. Taylor St. onto W. Durand St. and turn left into the parking lot.




Integrated Engineering Services Building (IESB) (Building 2102)
